New Topic - A Bug's Life

Literacy - Stories with repetition. News writing. Remembering to punctuate, use finger spaces, use time words e.g. next, then, later etc.

Maths - Addition and subtraction word problems. Using a numberline to count on and back. Money to 20p

Geography - Map of the sensory garden.

History - Old and new photos of the school. Looking at the past and present.
