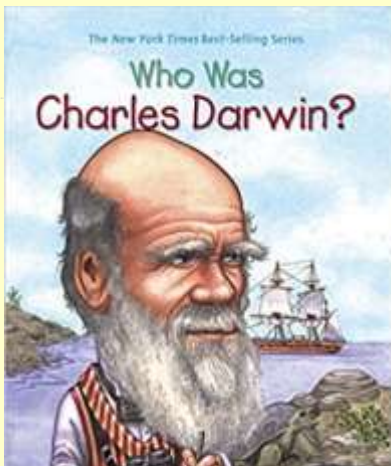
**Maths** - Doubling numbers up to 10 then 20. Word problems that involve doubling.
