Topic - People who help us - Paramedics Children to ask questions about the paramedics role and equipment.

Literacy Retell the story of The Little Red Hen. Introduce the class story map and discuss the beginning of the story. Children to draw the beginning and try to write sounds heard in words. Introduce sounds y, z, zz, qu

Year 1 News

Maths Counting forwards and backwards up to 20 learning how to write/read number words e.g. nine.

Literacy Introducing verbs and identifying verbs. Writing instructions for how to cross the road using bossy and time words.

Year 2 News

Literacy Writing expanded noun phrases about pictures from the story "The Way Back Home". e.g. The shiny, silver and dusty plane flew higher and higher.

Maths Multiplication. Solving problems practically and pictorially. Counting in 3s.

History- Learning about Neil Armstrong and the moon landing.

Maths Counting an irregular arrangement of objects. Model how to count accurately. Finding one more than a given number using objects then working it out mentally.

Art/DT Cooking - Pitta Pockets - skills grating and cutting.

ICT Espresso - People Who Help Us. Using the search tool. Sorting healthy/unhealthy foods. Word Art - Calendar names.

History - discussing the visit from Florence Nightingale and labelling pictures to show what changes she made to hospitals.

DT - Making and decorating clay divas.

Science - Discussing the weather/seasons and looking at extreme weather.

Science - Investigating materials to find which is the stretchiest and using that material to make an astronaut's belt.

Art Printing planets on our backgrounds using bottle tops and corks.

DT - Finish making our space themed clay tile.
