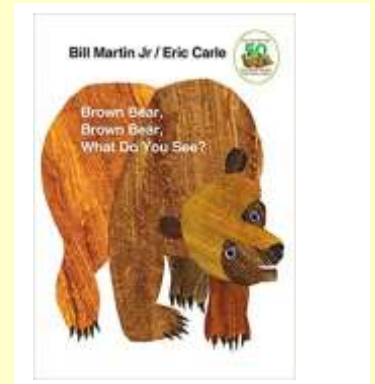
Maths - Introduce 'adding' and 'total' - use compare bears to combine 2 groups to find the total. Introduce the symbols + =
