Colour - Camille and the Sunflowers - a story about Vincent Van Gogh

Literacy - Read Camilla and the Sunflowers. Write the story words using a phoneme frame and applying Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds.

Talk for Writing - Little Red Riding Hood. Retell the story using actions.

Revise Phase 3 sounds th, ng, ai, ee, oa, oo, ar, or, ow.

Maths Adding one more to a number - work it out practically and pictorially

Art/DT - Take your pencil for a walk. Look at the work of Miro. Sunflower heads.

Year 1 News

Literacy - Making a missing poster about the boy from the book "Lost & Found" and making a missing poster for the penguin. Our reading lesson will be based on making predictions.

Maths - Continuing to count forwards and backwards to 50 from any number. Looking at missing number tracks and learning to count in 2s to 20.

Geography - Looking at the continents of North and South America and completing the last page in our around the world atlas.
