New Topic - 'Animals' Dear Zoo

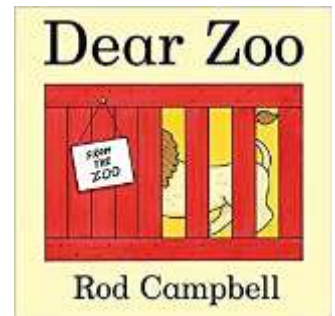
