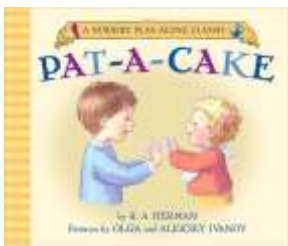

Cooking Cakes

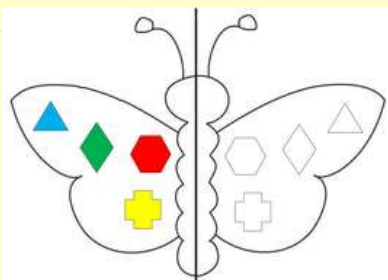
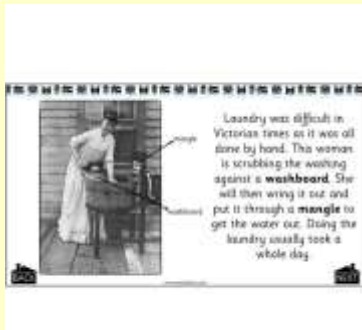
ICT - Nursery Rhymes and Scene builder
