Topic Who helps you at home?

Literacy - Complete the end of The Gingerbread Man story on the story map. News writing - starting the sentence with I and writing the sounds they hear. Introduce phase 2 sounds ck, e, u, r

Maths Recognising numbers up to 10 -

counting out the correct number of objects. Look at 2D shapes and their properties - sides, corners, straight, curved. Introduce some 3D shapes to build a home

Art/DT - Create models using blocks - build a home. Ideas for role play. Playdough with glitter. Paint someone who helps at home.

ICT - Colour magic using flood-fill text.



Year 1 News

Literacy - Firework senses poem writing about what we can hear, see and feel. Reading lesson focusing on the prediction “viper”.

Maths Looking at take away word problems and how to use a number line to take away.

Science Looking at the weather and learning about the seasons.

History - Looking at Guy Fawkes and sequencing events.

DT - Looking at clay and discussing clay divas.

Year 2 News

Literacy Exploring fantasy settings and then designing our own fantasy settings e.g. upside down land. We are also going to learn about the moon and the sun and write sentences to describe and compare them.

Maths - Number bonds. Using our number bonds to help us efficiently add 3 single digit

numbers together. Solving problems involving number bonds.

History - Learning about Neil Armstrong. Who is he? Why is he famous?

DT - Look at images of space pottery. Children to design own space tiles.

Art - look at the artist Peter Thorpe.
