- It is important to involve parents, carers and children in establishing and maintaining good behaviour and to provide positive role models in governors and staff.
- We strongly believe in the principles of equal opportunities and value cultural diversity. We will not tolerate bullying, violence, racism or sexism or any form of discrimination.
- We have developed a clear system of rewards and sanctions which are to be applied consistently.
- We have responsibility to support those children with emotional and behavioural needs to enable them to be educated with their peers wherever possible.
- We endorse the school's behaviour policy and undertake to monitor its effectiveness and to support staff in its implementation.
- We will ensure that teachers can teach and children can learn in an atmosphere of respect, security and enthusiasm.
