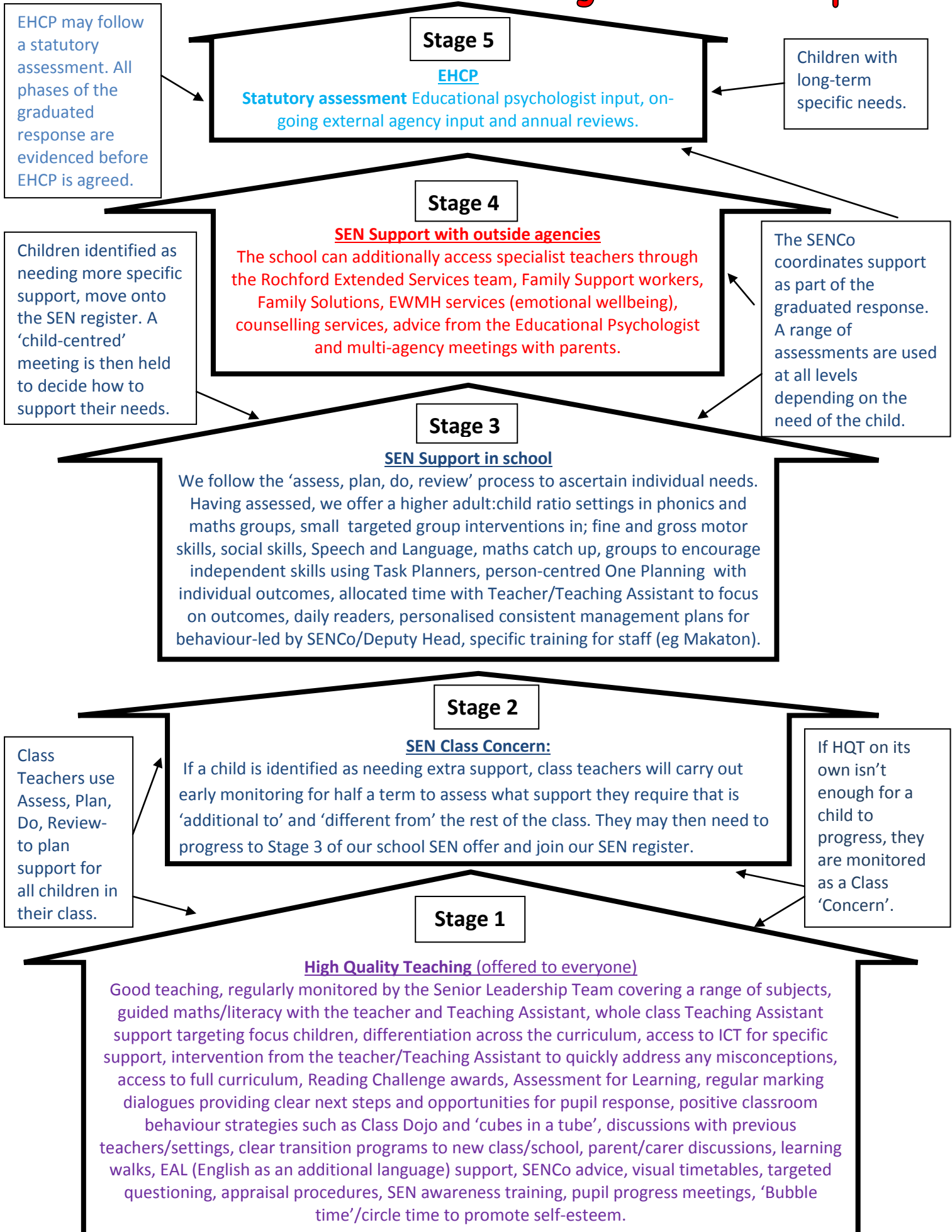



Holt Farm Infant School-our graduated response



SEN Information Report 2018

- ✓ At Holt Farm Infant School all teachers are responsible for SEND provision in the school.
- ✓ The SENCo, Danielle Browne, has achieved the National Award for SEN Coordination
- ✓ Teachers have an SEND class provision map tracking children in their class on the SEN register.
- ✓ The Class Teacher, SENCo, TA, parent and child views are included in One Planning meetings.
- ✓ One Plans with clear outcomes are available to all staff working with the child.
- ✓ Structured end of year handover meetings are held to enable teachers to pass on information.
- ✓ Training for specific learning difficulties is offered as required e.g. dyslexia through Essex/RES.
- ✓ All Teaching Assistants are trained in First Aid, all staff have received 'Workplace First Aid' training.
- ✓ Medical training is offered to all staff as required. Epipen+diabetes training was received Sept 2017.
- ✓ Training is offered to lunch supervisors as needs arise.
- ✓ A member of staff has received Makaton training.
- ✓ The whole staff (teachers and teaching assistants) have received level 1 Autism training
- ✓ The SENCo and 3 LSAs have received Talk Boost training to support children with language delay.
