### Year 1

#### Topic –“Through the Keyhole”

**Literacy** – Sequencing the story of The Three Little Pigs and planning their own story. Creating a ‘Wanted’ poster for the wolf writing descriptive sentences.

**Maths** - Find one more than a number and one less than a number practically and using a numberline. Being able to say one more/one less than a given number.

**Science** – Testing materials – children to discuss ideas for how to test the materials and find out the answer. Discuss their findings.

**History** – Look at Victorian toys and games that children used to play. Compare the toys with modern day toys.

**Geography** – Look at houses around the world and what they are made from. How do they differ from houses and homes in this country.

**Art/DT** – Completing their model house for the 4<sup>th</sup> Little Pig using a range of materials.

## Year 2

### Topic –“Great Fire of London”

**Maths** - This week we will be working on addition, we will be adding 2 and then 3 digit numbers together and solving addition problems.

**Literacy** – Write a letter to The King explaining how and why London should be re-built. To write from King Charles and Samuel Pepys perspective about the Fire of London. Discuss the past tense and how we add 'ed' to words.

**Art** – Marbling using flame colours to create a silhouette picture.

**DT** – Evaluating our finished tudor houses.
